The Erasmus Mundus Master **CCD-STeDe** aims to create experts in the area of sustainable territorial development in the context of climate change. More concretely it trains professionals to be able to help organizations acting in the territory (enterprises, local communities, civil society organizations, public administrations) to draft sustainable development policies combining economic, social, environmental, international and intercultural dimensions.

Each academic year, 20 Erasmus Mundus scholarships are granted to the best-ranked applicants, and distributed among the 4 paths.
